
AB 1550, the Climate Investments for CA Communities Act: Increased Benefits for Senate District 27

SD 27 and the surrounding area already benefit from Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund investments. AB 1550 takes the next step. benefitting over 91,000 households in the district with incomes 80% of the state median or less.

In an affluent region, SD 27 has too much poverty: Based on their incomes, roughly 91,000 households (28% of the district) would be eligible for benefits under AB 1550, whether or not they live in designated Disadvantaged Communities.

Available benefits include home weatherization, clean vehicle rebates, public transportation, affordable housing near transit, urban forestry, low-cost solar power and more.



New areas eligible for investments under AB 1550

Already funded in SD 27

- \$7.3 million within the district

SD 27 is disproportionately impacted by air pollution

SD 27 faces serious air pollution problems. Ventura County received a failing grade for ozone pollution in the American Lung Association's 2016 State of the Air report, while Los Angeles County received failing grades for ozone and particulate pollution.

GGRF-funded projects in SD 27

The vast majority of GGRF benefits to the district came from the Clean Vehicle Rebate Project. Roughly \$7.2 million in rebates were issued to over 3,500 residents to replace highly polluting cars. CVRP promotes the adoption of clean vehicles by distributing up to \$6,500 in rebates for the purchase or lease of battery electric, plug-in hybrid and fuel cell vehicles.

SD 27 also benefited from the \$1.7 million Pacific Surfliner Transit Transfer Program grant. This grant will support seamless ticketing and transfer policies in the Los Angeles - San Diego - San Luis Obispo Rail Corridor.

Residents of SD 27 and the transit agencies that serve them also received financing to replace polluting vehicles through the hybrid and zero-emission truck and bus voucher program and the enhanced fleet modernization program. Some funding was also allocated to SD 27 for solar installation and weatherization for single-family homes.
