

# AB 1550, the Climate Investments for CA Communities Act: Increased Benefits for Senate District 31

SD 31 and the surrounding area already benefit from Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund investments. AB 1550 takes the next step, *benefitting over 104,000 households in the district with incomes 80% of the state median or less.*

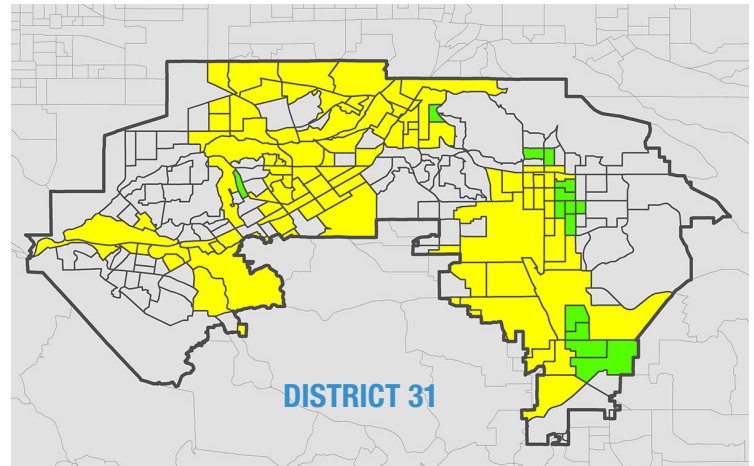
## SD 31 is seriously impacted by poverty

Based on their incomes, over 104,000 households would be eligible for benefits under AB 1550, *whether or not they live in designated Disadvantaged Communities.*

Available benefits include home weatherization, clean vehicle rebates, public transportation, affordable housing near transit, urban forestry, low-cost solar power and more.

## SD 31 is disproportionately impacted by air pollution

Riverside County received an “F” grade for both particle and ozone pollution in the American Lung Association’s 2016 State of the Air Report.

## Sample GGRF-funded projects in SD 31

**Water-Energy Community Action Network Program, Riverside:** \$2.3 million will bring water savings to 260 homes and energy savings to 1,703 homes in disadvantaged communities. Services provided will include turf replacement and full house retrofits, including attic insulation, weather-stripping and window replacement.

**March Veterans Village, Riverside:** \$6.1 million awarded to the Coachella Valley Housing Coalition will build 138 affordable housing units for veterans on the old March Air Force Base. The site, which currently serves 119 veterans, will be expanded in stages to provide over 400 veterans with case management services, transitional housing and permanent housing.

Other funded projects will improve transit services in Perris, Moreno Valley and Riverside. In addition, 839 residents of the district have received \$1,635,950 in rebates from the Clean Vehicle Rebate Project to purchase or lease clean electric or plug-in hybrid vehicles.
